UK SOLE REPRESENTATIVE VISA, WHAT IS IT?

The UK Sole Representative Visa is an initiative launched by the UK Government to boost, and stimulate, the UK economy post BREXIT. This program is designed specifically to attract overseas non-EU companies to establish a new presence in the United Kingdom. The Sole Representative route is a business visa, and residency program, which allows foreign nationals, from an overseas company, to open a branch office in the UK. The main applicant, the sole representative, will receive full UK residency for themselves, and their dependents, with access to free education, free healthcare and a pathway to citizenship.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Shareholders of an overseas company
- Key decision makers/senior employees who are not shareholders.
- Parent company must be headquartered outside the UK
- The company must have been established for more than a year
- The company must be active, with minimum turnover of \$100, 000
- Controlling stake of the company must remain overseas.

HOW LONG DOES THE **VISA** LAST?

- You will receive a three year residency granted (BRP). The residency is extended for 2 years after the initial three years
- After completing five years in the UK, you can apply for permanent residency (ILR)
- After receiving permanent residency, the following year, you can apply for British Citizenship.



HOW LONG DOES THE **PROCESS** TAKE?

The overall process, in order to secure the sole representative visa, can take up to 10 weeks. However in some circumstances, if a client has a particularly strong case, with all relevant documentation ready, we may be able to process their application within 60 days.

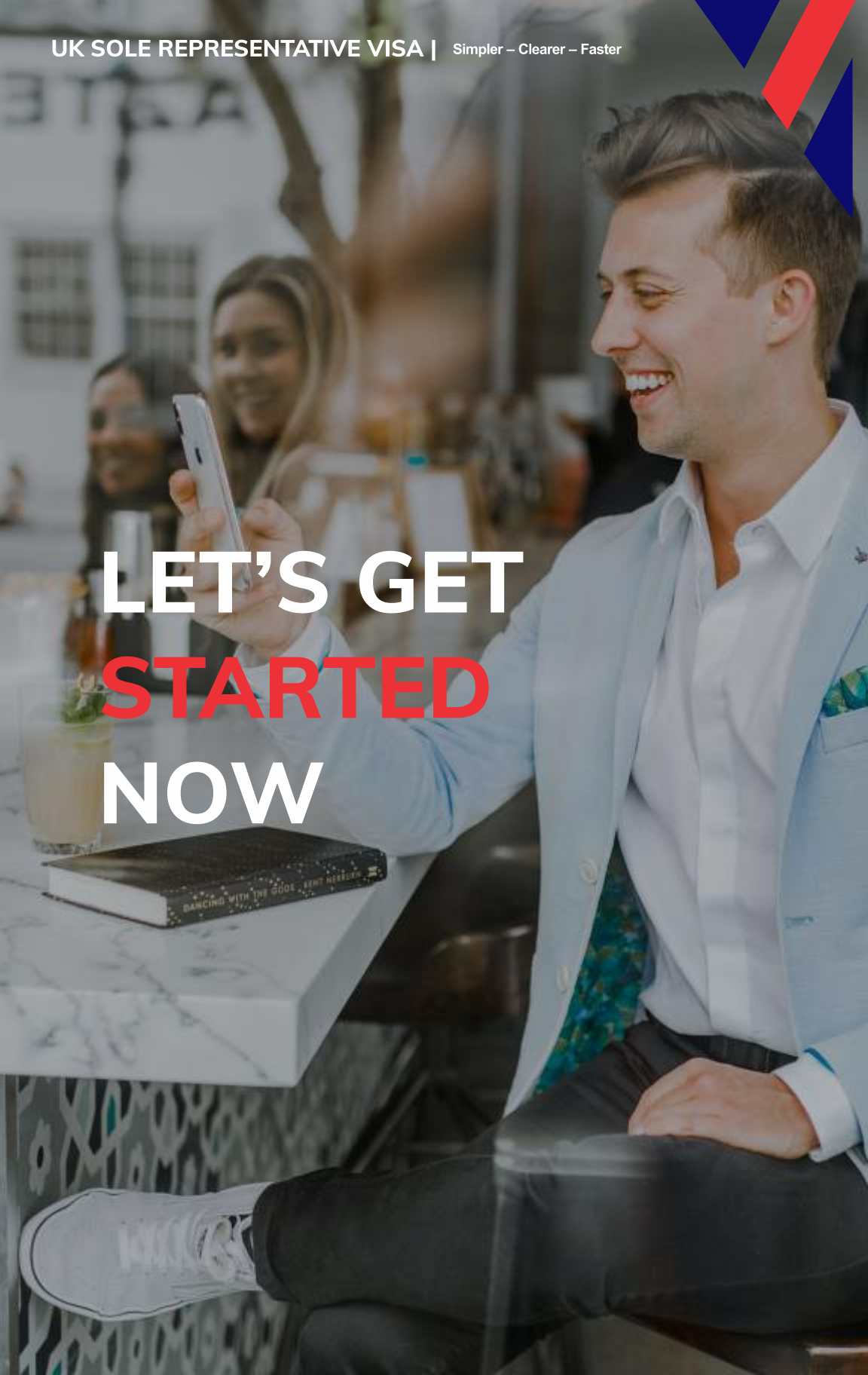

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

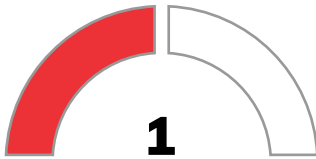
The overall cost of this program can be broken down into two (2) parts.
UK Citizenship's Legal Fees - UK Government Fees.

OUR FEES

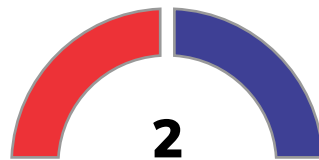
UK Citizenship's fee for the processing and structuring of a sole representative application is dependent on the amount of case hours involved, and the overall complexity of the case. Once you have completed an initial consultation our expert team will be able to provide a quotation.

UK GOVERNMENT FEES

The government fees for the sole representative program are broken down into two (2) payments.



NHS - Initial Health Surcharge. a. £1,872 per applicant.



Government Administrative Fee. a. £610 per applicant.

PAYMENT PLAN



UK Citizenship Fee:

Initial Deposit 50% On signing contract and UK Citizenship Fee.



Payment of 25% Business plan completion (Week4 - 5) UK Government Fees.



NHS & Admin Fee £2,482 on submission of application (Week 7 - 8) UK Citizenship Fee.



Final Payment 25% on approval of the application (Week 8 - 10).



CAN SOMEONE GO WITH ME?

The main applicant, the sole representative, will be able to include his/her dependents in the application. Spouse and children under the age of 18. Dependents can work or study full-time in the United Kingdom.
